- Mr. Rudra Chatterjee (MD, Luxmi Tea) – Discussed the importance of experiential tourism integrated with MICE offerings.
- Mr. Darshan Dudhoria (Co-Founder, Bari Kothi) – Shared insights on boutique venues as unique event destinations.
- Mr. Mohammad Ali (Director of Global Sales – India, Accor) – Provided a hotel industry perspective on attracting international MICE events.
- Dr. Sanjay Miglani (President, Indian Dental Association) – Highlighted the need to attract international medical conferences to the region.
